

Uniform (Required on Non-Chapel Days)

Polo Shirts can be short or long sleeved.

	Shoes	All	Tennis Shoes/Sneakers (no flip flops), shoes must have a back strap and be suitable for outdoor play.
7 th grade- 12 th grade	Polos	All	Black, White or school Purple
	Bottoms	Boys	Black or Khaki shorts or pants(must wear a belt)
		Girls	Black or Khaki shorts, pants, skirt or skirt
	Shoes	All	No flip flops

P E Uniforms

Students in Kindergarten-2nd grade will wear P E uniforms all day on P E days. Students 3rd grade -12th grade will wear the appropriate uniform to school and change into P E uniforms later in the day.

Pre-K does not participate in P E so they will not wear P E uniforms.

K-6 th grade	Approved P E shirt and shorts that must be purchased from CCS. Tennis shoes/sneakers Cold weather – Students may wear solid gray or black athletic pants or sweats with no visible logos
7 th grade – 12 th grade	Approved P E shirt that must be purchased from CCS. Basketball shorts Tennis shoes/sneakers Cold weather – Students may wear solid gray or black athletic pants or sweats with no visible logos

Chapel Uniform 7th-12th grade only (Required on Chapel Days Only)

7 th grade- 12 th grade	Girls	White button up blouse with black pants, skirt or scooter. A solid white, black or school purple camisole must be worn under the white button up blouse.
7 th grade- 12 th grade	Boys	White oxford shirt worn with a tie. Black pants with a belt.

Outerwear Items (Chapel, Uniform, & P E Uniform Days)

<u>Approved In-Classroom Outerwear</u>	
PreK- 6 th grade	Navy zip-up hoodie, sweater or jacket Approved purple CCS hoodie (please contact office for purchase)
7 th grade – 12 th grade	Black or Navy zip-up hoodie, sweater or jacket Approved purple CCS hoodie (please contact office for purchase) CCS Letter jackets

Any other outerwear (large coats) may be any style, color, or pattern BUT MAY NOT BE WORN INSIDE THE CLASSROOM.

Requirements & Non-Approved Items for All Students

1. All skirts, shorts, and dresses must cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of the thigh. CCS does not accept the "finger-tip rule" as measurement for the length of the above items.
2. Skinny jeans, form fitting clothing, running shorts, Capri's, cargo pants or shorts, and low rise pants or shorts are not allowed.
3. Leggings are only allowed when worn under a skirt, dress, or shirt of dress length. See lengths listed above.
4. Boys' shirts must be tucked in at all times. They need to be long enough to stay tucked when arms are raised.
5. Girls' shirts must follow the above guidelines but are not required to tuck shirts in.
6. No logos should be present on the front of polo's, blouses, shorts, or pants. This does not apply when participating in Purple or Jeans days.
7. All clothing including uniforms, purple day attire, & jeans attire should be neat, clean & in good repair.
8. Hats are not to be worn in the building.

Administration reserves the right to make judgments concerning the dress code as deemed necessary.

Uniform Infractions

Students not abiding by the dress code will receive 1 warning per each 6 week grading period. Any further infraction (s) will result in an unexcused absence for the time that the student must be absent from class to change into the proper attire.
