All Blacks are Black Khakis.

All undershirts should be plain without piping, writing or logos and must be a uniform color.

P E Uniforms

Students in Kindergarten-2nd grade will wear P E uniforms all day on P E days. Students 3rd -12th grade will wear the appropriate uniform to school and change into P E uniforms later in the day.

Pre-K does not participate in P E so they will not wear P E uniforms.

Any outerwear (large coats) may be any style, color, or pattern BUT MAY NOT BE WORN INSIDE THE CLASSROOM.

Requirements & Non-Approved Items for All Students

1. All skirts, shorts, and dresses must cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of the thigh. CCS does not accept the "finger-tip rule" as measurement for the length of the above items.
2. Skinny jeans, form fitting clothing, running shorts, Capris, cargo pants or shorts, and low rise pants or shorts are not allowed.
3. Leggings are only allowed when worn under a skirt, dress, or shirt of dress length. See lengths listed above.
4. Boys' shirts must be tucked in at all times. They need to be long enough to stay tucked when arms are raised.
5. Girls' shirts are not required to tuck in but must cover mid-section when arms are raised.
6. No logos should be present on the front of polo's, blouses, shorts, or pants. This does not apply when participating in Purple or Jeans days.
7. All clothing including uniforms, purple day attire, & jeans attire should be neat, clean & in good repair.

- Hats are not to be worn in the building.

Administration reserves the right to make judgments concerning the dress code as deemed necessary.

Uniform Infractions

Students not abiding by the dress code will receive 1 warning per each 6 week grading period. Any Further infraction(s) will result in an unexcused absence for the time that the student must leave class to change into the proper attire.

Students that arrive at school who are not in appropriate uniform attire may be issues a CCS PE shirt and black sweat pants to wear for the remainder of the day. Any student who is issued these items will be billed \$20 for the items.
